Instructions to Researchers

- Only original previously unpublished researches will be considered.
- Manuscripts should be typed (word 2000) with double spacing on one side of the sheet, and three copies should be submitted with (CD). Researchers should include their names (first name, middle initial and last name of each researcher), and their current address for correspondence. Original papers should have the following sections (each of which should begin with a new page): title page/abstract/introduction/materials and methods/results/discussion.
- Only previously unpublished researches may be submitted. And the researcher is requested to include a statement to this effect in his letter of submission.
- Researchers should adhere to a sound research methodology.
- All researches will be sent to specialized referees confidentially.
- Contributors may not send their manuscripts to other journals for publication until they receive a reply from the journal of Al – Qadisiya for human sciences.
- Researchers should edit their researches in accordance with the referees' recommendations and the instructions of the journal.
- Papers published in the journal are not to exceed (25) printed pages of the journal. The manuscripts will not be given back whether published or not.
- An abstract both in Arabic and English should be included, and it should not exceed (150) words.
- Figures and tables should be numbered consecutively and given titles using black ink.
- Reference numbers should be written between square brackets. A list of references, typed in their serial order, should be given on a separate sheet of paper.
- After delivering the manuscript in a CD, the researcher will be responsible for all the printing, linguistic and spelling mistakes.
- The journal adopts the self-funding system and decides the publishing price in accordance with average prices.
- Every researcher is provided with three copies of the research. The journal copy is requested from the secretary after paying the determined price.
- It is possible to publish advertisements that participate in expounding the scientific, industrial and economical sides of the country after a money gift paid by the institution of concern.
- Published researches are arranged according to the field of specialization and not according to the scientific ranks of the researchers.
- The researcher is responsible ethically, socially and legally for any illiterate quotation or adoption of the others' efforts especially literal taking from the internet.
